The scholarship competition aims at selecting the **Best International Profiles** and at supporting develop their **outstanding talents**.

For this very reason, NABA offers **SIX 40% SCHOLARSHIPS** to partially cover the tuition fee for the Bachelor of Arts Degree Programs in Graphic Design and Art Direction, Design, Fashion Design, Media Design and Multimedia Arts, Theatre and Exhibit Design, Painting and Visual Arts starting in October 2017.

SELECTION

Creativity is not an abstract exercise, on the contrary, it requires the ability to contextualize elaborate information and look for new solutions with an open spirit capable of listening and interacting.

NABA will award scholarships to the best candidates on the basis of the results of the Entry Assessment Test taken via distance evaluation through portfolio assessment.

NABA will evaluate your capability to take decisions in terms of selection of your works and way to present them together with technical skills already known.

REQUIRED MATERIALS

Candidates willing to participate must submit the following materials:

- Artistic portfolio of projects and works¹
- Artistic statement
- NABA Three-year Bachelor of Arts Degree Application Form 2017/2018
- Copy of high school diploma (if available), translated into English or Italian or School Attendance Certificate of the 12th year.
- Copy of high school academic transcripts, translated into English or Italian
- Copy of the passport
- Competition application form here attached

** Application fee of 150,00 EUR is waived for competition participants.*

AUDIENCE

The competition is open to:

- International students holding a valid high school diploma, equivalent to an Italian secondary school diploma (obtained at the end of a period of study lasting at least 12 years).
- International students about to graduate from the high school within the academic year 2016/17.

PRIZES

Six 40% scholarships on the full standard tuition fee (15.810 Euros net of regional tax for non EU students or 13.390 Euros net of regional tax for EU students) for the following NABA BA programs starting in October 2017 and valid for the Academic Year 2017/18:

- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Graphic Design and Art Direction, English or Italian language
- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Design, English or Italian language
- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Fashion Design, English or Italian language
- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Media Design and Multimedia Arts, Italian language
- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Theatre and Exhibit Design, Italian language
- One 40% scholarship for the BA Program in Painting and Visual Arts, Italian language

JURY

The submitted applications will be selected and evaluated by leading Faculty of the chosen BA Program.

DEADLINES

Interested candidates shall upload the requested materials on www.competition.naba.it or submit via e-mail at competitions@naba.it indicating in the subject "NABA's Got Talent Competition 2017" by and not later than 10th March 2017.

When you submit your project, you will receive a confirmation within 48 hours that your submission was received.

If you do not receive a confirmation, let us know at competitions@naba.it

Final results will be communicated to participants via email by 31st March 2017.

The decision of the Jury is final.

If no candidate satisfies the requirements defined by the Jury, NABA reserves the right not to assign all available scholarships.

Winners of the partial scholarships must accept them by sending an email to admissions@naba.it by and not later than April 7th 2017 in order not to lose the right to the scholarship.

Once the prizes have been accepted, winners must confirm their participation in the BA Program by sending copy of the pre-enrollment fee payment by and not later than April 14th 2017.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Each scholarship covers 40% of the tuition fee for the 1st year of the chosen 3-year BA Degree Program. The scholarship is renewable for 2nd and 3rd year if specific academic criteria are met². The amount of the scholarship will be discounted from the overall tuition fees equivalent to 15.810 Euros (net of regional tax) for non EU students or 13.390 Euros (net of regional tax) for EU students. The scholarship will be deducted from the balance of the tuition fee and is calculated on the net fee, regional tax excluded.

Should the evaluation of two candidates result equivalent, NABA will choose the winner according to the Grade Point Average obtained during the high school (up until the moment when the application is presented).

Assigned scholarships that aren't redeemed could be transferred to the next candidate in the ranking list.

The scholarships presented in this public announcement cannot be combined with other economic reductions offered by NABA.

PROPERTY RIGHTS

Every moral or paternity right of all submitted works are property of the author.

The works sent to NABA will not be returned. Rights related to exhibition, publication and broadcasting of winners' works belong both to the authors and to NABA (and the related organization).

¹ Portfolio Submission

A portfolio of projects is the presentation of yourself, of your previous academic and/or professional and/ or amateural experiences. There's no need to include many projects rather a selection of your main works either academic or professional or amateural that will let us understand your skills and potentials. Each portfolio will be assessed taking into account creativity, commitment, original ideas, layout, and technical skills.

Guidelines to the preparation of the Digital portfolio:

- Personal information: name, surname, date and place of birth, nationality, address, email address, telephone nr.
- 5 to 10 projects: each project should be divided into separate folders (they can be drawings, illustrations, computer graphic, photos, videos, ...)
- Each project should have a pdf description containing: title of the project, year of production, information if it is a project developed at school, on your own, ...
- Digital formats:
- Photos, graphic projects, drawings, sketches: PDF (including fonts), JPG or PNG 300 dpi
- Websites: complete folder including html, css, images, swf, other. If it is online: please provide us with the url web
- Videos: MPEG4 or AVI
- Texts, researches or presentations: PDF

² **Renewal for 2nd year:** minimum 30 credits and general average exams score not lower than 27/30 by the end of the fall exam session.
Renewal for 3rd year: minimum 88 credits and general average exams score not lower than 27/30 by the end of the fall exam session.
